Items covered in the General Subscription: textbook loan, laundry, internet access, most extra-curricular activities, contribution to travel and accommodation when representing the school and pupils' personal accident insurance.

Items not covered in the General Subscription: speech and drama, instrumental music, riding, public examination fees, private sports lessons and EAL tuition.

Deposit (applicable to overseas students only): in addition to the above fees, a deposit equal to one term's fees is payable before entry. This deposit is refundable, less the final term's expenses, when the pupil leaves the school.

Fees in Advance: The School operates a fees in advance scheme which offers a discount for fees paid in advance for future terms. Further details are available from the Fees Office.

Speech and Drama: £105 per term (shared lessons)

Instrumental Charges: £210 per first instrument per term (for up to 30 lessons per academic year, £21.00 per additional lesson thereafter). Subsequent instruments are charged at £195 per term.

Riding Charges:

Riding Tuition	£14.75 to £38.25 per lesson
Polo	£20.00 per group session
Use of School horse	£11.50 extra per lesson
Full Livery	£125 per week

Note for new applicants to the School

The following non-refundable fees are payable during the application process:

- a. Registration Fee to accompany the completed Registration Form £150
 - b. Acceptance Fee to accompany the completed Acceptance Form £500
- (The sum of £250 will be retained by the school and the balance of £250 will be credited against the final school bill. For those who do not take up their place, Millfield Preparatory School will retain the whole Acceptance Fee).*

Notice: one full term's written notice from parents to the Headmistress is required on withdrawal of a pupil and on transfer from boarding to day status. Those failing to do this will be charged one term's fees in lieu of notice. A term's written notice is also required for Music and Riding or a term's fees for extra tuition will be charged.

Payment of Fees: please note that fees are due and payable to the Fees Office before the first day of each term unless otherwise agreed in accordance with a separate agreement with the School. We regret that such a separate agreement will only be open to parents who hold a UK bank account. Interest will be charged at a monthly rate, detailed on the fees invoice, for fees that are not paid by the first day of term.
